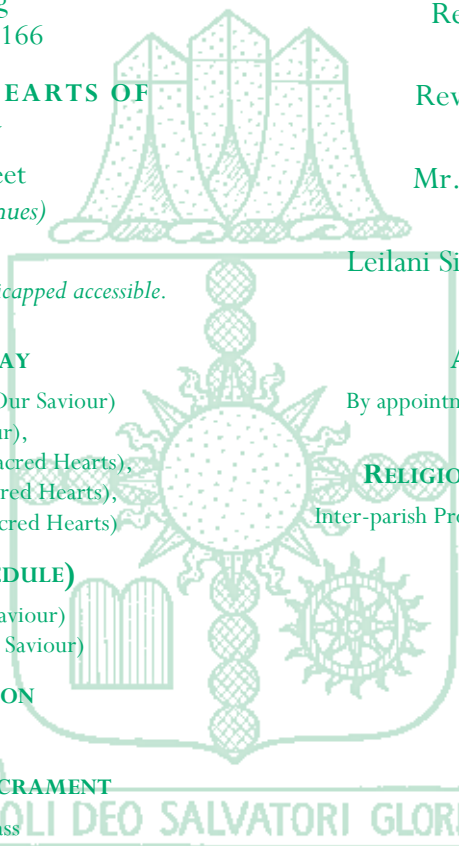

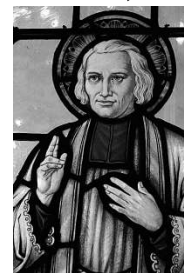
ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY – TUESDAY, 15 AUGUST

A Holy Day of Obligation

ST. JOHN MARY VIANNEY (4 AUGUST)

Born in 1786 near Lyon, France, this farmer's son studied for the priesthood for many years and eventually was ordained, more for his devoutness and good will than for other qualities. But he became a model parish priest in Arsen-Dombes, where he served for forty years. He was devoted to his parishioners and became famous for rigorous preaching and his insights in the confessional. The Curé of Ars, as he was known, spent no less than eleven hours a day hearing the confessions of pilgrims who sought him out. He is the patron of parish priests. St. John Mary Vianney died in 1859.



DEDICATION OF THE BASILICA OF ST. MARY MAJOR (5 AUGUST)



This feast commemorates the miracle of the snowfall that occurred during the night of 4–5 August in the year 358 on the site where the Basilica now stands. According to tradition, the Virgin Mary appeared in a dream to two faithful Roman Christians, the patrician John and his wife, as well as to Pope Liberius (352–366), asking that a church be built in her honor on the site where the snow would fall. Pope Liberius traced the outlines of the church in the snow and the first basilica was built on that site. The Basilica was completed about a century later by Pope Sixtus III (432–440), after the Council of Ephesus in 431, during which Mary was declared to be the Mother of God. The Basilica of St. Mary Major, located on the Esquiline Hill, is home to an image of Our Lady known as *Salus Populi Romani*, Protectress and Health of the Roman People. Pope Francis visited the Basilica on the morning following his election and, whenever he makes an apostolic visit outside Italy, he visits the Basilica to venerate the image.
