## MASS INTENTIONS

### **DAILY MASS AT SACRED HEARTS**

Daily Mass will not be celebrated at the Chapel of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary during the months of July and August.

Beginning Tuesday, 5 September, Daily Mass (Monday–Friday) will be celebrated at Sacred Hearts at 5:15 p.m. As announced previously, it is not practical for us as a parish to have two daily Masses occurring simultaneously. In turn, implementing this Mass enables the parish to offer Mass in the morning, at midday, and in the early evening. We hope that parishioners, commuters, and employees and visitors for the nearby hospitals will take advantage of this new Mass time. *Additionally, beginning Tuesday, 5 September, the Chapel will be open for private prayer on weekdays from 9:00 a.m. until the end of the 5:15 p.m. Mass.*

### **PRAY THE ROSARY**

Every Sunday, after the 12:45 p.m. Mass at the Chapel, parishioners pray the Rosary near the statue of the Pietà. You are warmly invited to join the group and offer to Our Lady any intentions that you may have.

### **ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT**

Every Friday, after the 7:45 a.m. Mass, we have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Church. Adoration concludes with Benediction at 11:55 a.m. Come, spend a few moments in quiet adoration.

### **OUR ABLUTION CUP**

Next to the tabernacle sits an ablution cup, which is used by the priest to purify his fingers after distributing Holy Communion. Sometime during July, the ablution cup at Our Saviour went missing. The Waterford Crystal cup was an ordination gift to the Pastor in 1974 and has great sentimental value. It cannot be replaced. If anyone has any information to help us locate the cup it would be genuinely appreciated. The church is open seven days a week from early morning until evening. As a result, we are the victim of thefts including things like votive candles and of people stuffing unwanted objects in the baptismal font and the confessionals, as well. As Pope Francis constantly reminds us, the church is to be accessible to as many people as possible. It would be a shame to have to change our hours.

### **RECOVERY SUNDAY – 10 SEPTEMBER**

Did you know that twenty million Americans struggle with addictive illnesses? Nine million children live in homes with one parent who has an addiction. Addictions to alcohol, drugs, and pornography are among those that require treatment and our prayers. “Jesus said to them, ‘This kind (of demon) cannot be driven out by anything but prayer and fasting.’” (Mark 9:29) Please join us in prayer on Recovery Sunday, which will take place in our parish on 10 September.

### **STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE U.S. CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS**

Cardinal Daniel N. DiNardo, of Galveston-Houston, President of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops has issued the following statement in response to the violent protests in Charlottesville, Virginia that has left three dead and at least 19 injured.

“On behalf of the bishops of the United States, I join leaders from around the nation in condemning the violence and hatred that have now led to one death and multiple injuries in Charlottesville, Virginia. We offer our prayers for the family and loved ones of the person who was killed and for all those who have been injured. We join our voices to all those calling for calm.

The abhorrent acts of hatred on display in Charlottesville are an attack on the unity of our nation and therefore summon us all to fervent prayer and peaceful action. The bishops stand with all who are oppressed by evil ideology and entrust all who suffer to the prayers of St. Peter Claver as we approach his feast day. We also stand ready to work with all people of goodwill for an end to racial violence and for the building of peace in our communities.

Last year a Task Force of our Bishops Conference under Archbishop Wilton Gregory [of Atlanta] proposed prayers and resources to work for unity and harmony in our country and in our Church. I am encouraging the bishops to continue that work especially as the Feast of St. Peter Claver approaches.”
