DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

Thursday, 9 November, marks the anniversary of the dedication of the Cathedral Church of Rome, on land owned by the Laterani Family, by Pope St. Sylvester I, on 9 November 324. Honored as the seat of the bishop of Rome, this basilica is the “mother and head of all churches of Rome and the world”. It served as the residence of the popes from the fourth century until their moving to Avignon in 1309 and it was the site of five ecumenical councils. Pope Innocent X commissioned the present structure in 1646. Beneath the high altar rests the remains of the small wooden table on which, according to tradition, St. Peter celebrated Mass. The Lateran Basilica is dedicated to Our Saviour and, later, to St. John the Baptist.
