ORGAN AT THE CHAPEL

As you may remember, before the merger of our parishes, the Church of St. Stephen made a gift to the Chapel of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary of a pipe organ, built by Hilborne Roosevelt, a respected nineteenth century organ builder, that had been located in the east gallery of the church. The idea was a good one – to preserve and share part of the patrimony and history of St. Stephen's with the congregation at the Chapel. Ever since the arrival of the pipe organ, however, we have experienced rather serious deterioration of the gift to the point where much of it is no longer functioning. As a result, the pipe organ has been removed for evaluation and possible further restoration. The existing electronic organ at St. Stephen's has been moved to the Chapel as an interim measure.

ST. FRANCES XAVIER CABRINI (1850–1917)

In 1946, Mother Cabrini was the first US citizen to be canonized; she is the universal patron of immigrants. She was born in Italy, the youngest of thirteen children, and became a school teacher. Denied admission to two religious orders because of frail health, she was given charge of an orphanage in Codogno. In 1880, she founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart with seven of her former orphans. The order spread rapidly from northern Italy to Rome, and then to New York City in 1889, where Mother Cabrini became famous for her work among the Italian immigrants. Before dying of malaria in Chicago, she had opened schools, orphanages, and hospitals around the United States, South America, and Europe. The Shrine of St. Frances Xavier Cabrini in the Washington Heights neighborhood of Manhattan is a place of pilgrimage for many and the remains of Mother Cabrini are enshrined in the chapel there.
