#### SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

A message full of hope resounds in the liturgy of Advent, inviting us to raise our gaze to the ultimate horizon but at the same time to recognize the signs of the God-with-us in the present. On this Second Sunday of Advent, the Word of God acquires the moving tones of the so-called "Second Isaiah", who announced to the Israelites, tried by decades of bitter exile in Babylon, liberation at last: "Comfort, comfort my people". This is what the Lord wishes to do in Advent: to speak to the heart of his people and through it to the whole of humanity, to proclaim salvation.

This year, the **FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT** is 24 December. Please note that the Saturday Vigil Mass and the Sunday Masses at 9:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., and 12:45 p.m. will be offered for the Fourth Sunday of Advent. Masses for the Nativity of the Lord (Christmas) begin with the 5:30 p.m. Mass on Sunday, 24 December. Catholics, of course, are obligated to attend Mass every Sunday and on holy days of obligation, among them the Nativity of the Lord. Since the Fourth Sunday of Advent and Christmas Eve fall on the same day, the question has been raised whether attending one Mass on Sunday, 24 December fulfills both obligations. However, the prevailing view of many canon lawyers is that *each obligation must be fulfilled with a separate Mass*.


