## SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

*Remaining in God's Love:* When we say that Christ loves his Church, we mean that he loves, nothing of earthly nature, but the fruit of his own grace; – the varied fruits of his grace in innumerable hearts, viewed as brought together in unity of faith and love and obedience, of sacraments, and doctrine, and order, and worship. The object which he contemplates, which he loves in the Church, is not human nature simply, but human nature illuminated and renovated by his own supernatural power.
