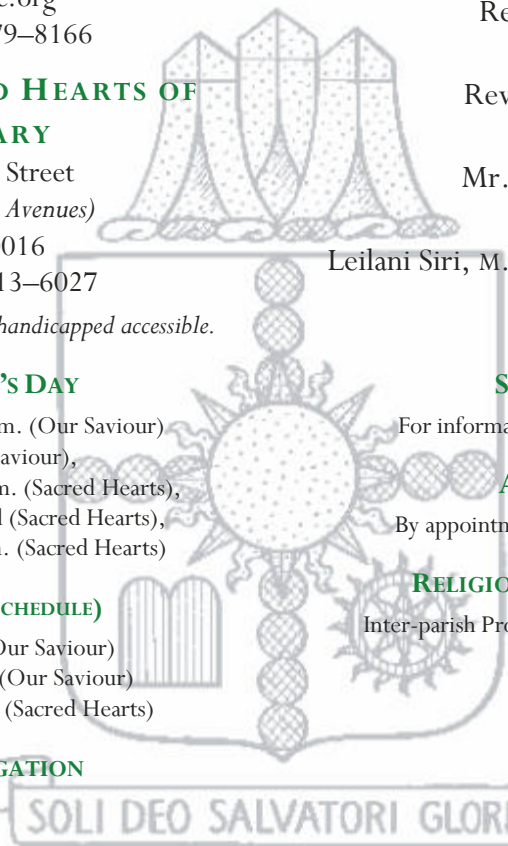

### MUSIC NOTES

The Choir of the Church of Our Saviour returns this Sunday, 16 September at the 11:00 a.m. Mass and the *Schola Cappella* resumes singing at the 12:45 p.m. Mass. The repertoire list for the season is available for you to bring home from church today. Please be sure to share it with friends who enjoy sacred music.

At the Offertory of the 11:00 a.m. Mass, the Choir sings *Like as the hart desireth the waterbrooks*, a setting of the first three verses of Psalm 42 by the English composer Herbert Howells (1892–1983). A pupil of Stanford, Howells wrote this poignant anthem during the Second World War. In September 1940 the Howells's house was bombed in the Blitz, resulting in the loss of his library and many manuscripts. He and his family moved temporarily to Cheltenham, about 100 miles northwest of London, where they were snowed in at the beginning of January 1941. During this time, Howells produced a new work every single day until 15 January, when he returned to London to teach at the Royal College of Music. This burst of activity included the composition of a set of anthems which he called *In Time of War*. Among them was *Like as the hart*, written on 7 January 1941. In it, one can hear the sense of fear and uncertainty that surrounded much of Europe during this time. The piece concludes with an unanswered question, a restatement of the second verse of Psalm 42: "*When shall I come to appear before the presence of God?*"

### TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY

Following Jesus means taking up one's cross and walking in his footsteps, along a difficult path which leads not to earthly power or glory but, if necessary, to self-abandonment, to losing one's life for Christ and the Gospel in order to save it. We are assured that this is the way to the resurrection, to true and definitive life with God. Choosing to walk in the footsteps of Jesus Christ, who made himself the Servant of all, requires drawing ever closer to him, attentively listening to his word and drawing from it the inspiration for all that we do ... Brothers and sisters, the path on which Jesus wishes to guide us is a path of hope for all. Jesus' glory was revealed at the very time when, in his humanity, he seemed weakest, particularly through the incarnation and on the cross. This is how God shows his love; he becomes our servant and gives himself to us. Is this not an amazing mystery, one which is at times difficult to accept? The Apostle Peter himself would only come to understand it later. *Benedict XVI*, 16 September 2012
