THE CHOIR OF THE CHURCH OF OUR SAVIOUR

The Choir of the Church of Our Saviour is a professional ensemble that sings every Sunday at the 11:00 A.M. Mass at the Church of Our Saviour and for liturgies at Christmas, the Easter Triduum, and other feasts throughout the year. Additionally, a quartet from the Choir, the *Schola Cappella*, sings twice a month at the 12:45 P.M. Mass at the Chapel of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. The choir's repertoire includes a wide range of sacred music from plainchant and polyphony to recently composed works. The members of the Choir are active musicians that perform regularly, both in ensembles and as soloists in New York and beyond. In 2015, the Choir released their first recording, *Hark! A Thrilling Voice is Sounding*, which is available for purchase from the Parish Office, on the parish website, or through iTunes and Amazon Music. THE ORGAN AT THE CHURCH OF OUR SAVIOUR

The original organ at the Church of Our Saviour was built in 1959 by M.P. Möller, Inc., as designed by Ernest White, sometime organist at Grace Church on Broadway. The present organ was built in 2005 by the Schantz Organ Company of Orrville, Ohio. Schantz installed their Opus 2258 in two chambers in the rear gallery, on both sides of the choir area. Several ranks from the original Möller organ were incorporated in this new instrument.
